INTRODUCTION

In April of 2026, my wife, Ana, lost her courageous battle with High-Grade Neuroendocrine Carcinoma (HG NEC) at just 33 years old. She was a fiercely loving mother to our three children and deeply passionate about the environment.

Ana believed in leaving the earth better than we found it—championing recycling, water conservation, and native planting. To celebrate her birthday, our community is coming together to honor her beautiful, eco-friendly spirit.

By uniting for a community clean-up and native bluebonnet planting, we are actively continuing her legacy while raising vital awareness and funds for rare neuroendocrine cancer research through the Neuroendocrine Tumor Research Foundation (NETRF).



Our Cause

Neuroendocrine cancers are uncommon, affecting approximately 225,000 people in the US, and currently have very few treatments available. Because they are difficult to diagnose, they often go undetected for years.

Rare and aggressive cancers like HG NEC desperately need more spotlight and funding. That is why 100% of the proceeds and donations from this event will directly benefit the Neuroendocrine Tumor Research Foundation (NETRF).

NETRF's mission is to fund research to discover cures and more effective treatments for neuroendocrine cancers.

We will spend the morning clearing the area of litter and separating recyclables. Afterward, we will plant a massive sea of drought-tolerant Texas Bluebonnets.

We are honored to partner with the City of Frisco Parks Department, who is generously supplying the bulk seeds, prepping the land, and providing on-site environmental education for our volunteers.
